# EXHIBITS FOR PETITION TO UNSEAL RECORDS FOR FOIA FBI FILE REQUEST NUMBER 1334338-000

**Exhibit 1:** First offender act discharge letter and envelope dated January 22, 2009 for first offender act case number 89cr2414 left by taking Adjudicated Without Guilt. It took 20 years before I can get this letter exonerating me and acknowledging that I should have had the first offender act for that whole 20 years. Officials deprived me of that right to claim my first offender act by illegally modifying my criminal background record and switching my first offender act to conviction without notice of hearing or provocation.

**Exhibit 2:** Conditions of Probation dated August 1992 confirms that Georgia probation office was well aware that I was no longer to be under their supervision was accepted by Michigan and had no right to submit a request for warrant for absconding.

**Exhibit 3:** A page from the court transcript from the first offender act which confirms that Lovelace flew to Georgia from Michigan to turn herself in on June 27th. Upon surrender the

sheriff's office in Decatur, instead of entering a surrender they opted to add two new charges. The charges were dismissed but the arrest stayed on my record for misleading purposes. The two additional charges made a combined total of five arrest entries for one incident and a single agency case number 13647.

**Exhibit 4:** A copy of an online Internet search for criminal history on March 8, 2014, for Tiwanda Lovelace revealed her name listed with an African American man's face with Petitioner Lovelace data mixed with incorrect charges. This is a sample of the information that is provided as criminal background history for employment and for housing.

**Exhibit 5:** A copy of employment offers and positions that were taken away due to their criminal background history entries and those misleading transmittals.

**Exhibit 6:** Internet State case report confirming petitioner was reporting as directed.

Exhibit 7: A copy of warrant dated May 18, 1993, from the DeKalb county alleging petitioner had absconded and refused to report and pay court ordered monies as instructed. Although petitioner was reporting as directed, they took it upon themselves to go in and issue a warrant for petitioner arrest. Per conditions of probation and interstate case reporting paperwork, they were aware and still got that warrant they then took the warrant and used it to take housing see exhibit. Just prior to them getting that warrant petitioner was living in Georgia at the time and they could have executed that warrant at any time, but they chose to wait until she had housing in Nevada.

**Exhibit 8:** A copy of a letter from department of housing and Urban development which says that the police and DeKalb County contacted housing to let them know that there was a warrant, and that they allege were unable to extradite. officers then proceeded to take her Section 8 housing, leaving petitioner and her children, homeless. Petitioner unable to secure and maintain employment due to their illegal background modification, entries, and misleading transmittals.

**Exhibit 9:** Recent email from Dept of Civil rights against the FBI; yet they referred me back to the FBI.

**Exhibit 10:** List (2) two examples of employment loss specifically due to deliberate maintenance of inaccurate and misleading entries.

**Exhibit 11:** A copy of contracts that were filed during the time frame covered under the FBI file and the time frame when petitioner alleged major copyright infringements. All the petitioner possessed a major co-publishing contract and copyrights of her own for her works and the list of songs on the radio on the top of the charts she was unable to locate and obtain and secure a lawyer for representation for over a decade.

**Exhibit 12:** Petitioner then filed lawsuits regarding her musical works and was met with blatant judicial misconduct we're in her complaints were referred to by the judge as a product of her female surgery. The courts in Michigan completely ignored copyrights actual violence that were happening to partitioner and her family. This was definitely a time frame when the FBI file was covered.

**Exhibit 13:** Unable to find Justice through the courts petitioner decided to get into online publishing to share her experiences through books and other products. Petitioner was told she would never make a dime for exposing what happened to her and due to the unfair practices,' petitioner has attached several documents from her online business which clearly shows some questionable actions that could clearly be condemned as intimidation unfair competition and unfair practices.

**Exhibit 14:** There was a flood of sellers on the first page of the exhibit even after opting out of third-party Sellers and over 2 years they reported no sales but were actually selling her products as used and new.

**Exhibit 15:** This exhibit shows one seller that was her competition was selling petitioner's own autobiography for \$33,418.88 while some sellers had it for \$0.78. This was during the time frame that the FBI file and that petitioner was seeking assistance from other governmental agencies to uphold her rights as a business owner, entrepreneur and a US citizen.

**Exhibit 16:** Exhibit: a copy of a contacts and attempted contacts of people in positions of power that refused to even acknowledge these blatant atrocities and examples of abuse of power.

**Exhibit 17:** The next exhibit shows mail delivery errors when reaching for assistance in attempting to contact those in positions to assist a copy of mail tampering a letter from three different mail carriers that Express unexplained delays when attempting to seek Justice. Exhibit 20: During this copyright infringements Lovelace was working with her copublishing company and they sent her a letter addressing her allegations of copyright infringements with the mail stamped or postmarked with the words, "comics" on a serious matter involving millions of dollars in music royalties on a top can recording. If I'm not mistaken the post office is under Federal jurisdiction, they were there at that time per the FBI file that I have so whoever was on this case was very well aware of what I was going through, and I never got no direct communication at any point while suffering from these violations.

**Exhibit 21:** Exhibit one a response letter from the department of Justice with the wrong ZIP code supposedly mailed from DC to Nevada stating that we have your materials, and we are not

going to investigate my allegations initialed by AM. I questioned the validity of that letter because of the ZIP code however it still came from the doj who I reached out to and it reference that I reached out to them but still no word. By editing my transmissions and blocking my business ventures, I've been corralled into homelessness while my Representatives and Officials will not offer the protection of the Constitution and uphold my rights in any legal matter which ultimately makes me a 'slave or the pet' that I've been referenced to ask for the last 30 plus years.

This letter is in response to your inquiry on certified mailing you sent to two (2) separate companies.

I regret you were unaware that addressees of certified mail have the option of appointing authorized agents to sign for their certified mail. The signatures appear to be similar but do not look identical or as the same person. Why Tree is a few of See Affack ments.

The reason for this policy is that many individuals receive large volumes of certified mail and they simply do not have the time to sign for every piece individually. For example, the President of the United States receives hundreds of pieces of accountable mail each day and he would have to spend hours signing receipts if we did not allow him to appoint agents.

Our records show, as indicated on the copies you sent this office, that the certified mail was delivered, signed for and dated at time of delivery.

I telephoned Zomba Company at (212) 620-8700 and spoke with an employee in the mailroom, in an attempt to find out the name of the person that signed for the mail in question. He assured me that he could not tell me who had signed for this particular mailpiece since the mail is delivered to the reception area and anyone available may sign for the company's mail.



# Cop-Killer Suspect Gives Up To Boyhood Friend, A Cop



ROBERT HEARD JR. . . . 'here I am, Dennis'

DETROIT (AP) — Promising there would be no shooting, Patrolman Dennis Clark talked a boyhood pal accused of slaying a policeman into surrendering Monday.

"Here I am, Dennis," said Robert Heard Jr., 23, Detroit, as he stepped out of the shadows of an apartment basement. Heard held his arms high in the air and limped slightly from a flesh wound in the leg, police said.

He was charged with firstdegree murder.

Heard and Paul Kincannon, 22, Detroit, were the object of an intensive manhunt after the Friday morning holdup slaying of Patrolman Stanley Rapaski, 35, and bar owner Casimar A. Czarwinski, 47, both of Detroit. Rapaski was off duty at the time.

Kincannon died Sunday after apparently shooting himself in the chest when police closed in, authorities said.

After learning that Heard was wanted in connection with the slayings, Clark spread word among old neighborhood friends that there would be no shooting if Heard surrendered, authorities said.

Heard called the patrolman shortly after midnight, saying he wanted to surrender.

"I know I can trust you," the young patrolman quoted Heard as saying.

Heard agreed to meet the patrolman in an apartment basement, where later Heard surrendered.

Clark, who has been on the force 18 months, said he had known Heard for 15 years. They grew up in the same Detroit neighborhood and worked together in a neighborhood boys club, Clark said.

"Then he went his way an I went mine," Clark added.







#### Murderer Gets Solitary Confinement

DETROIT (AP) — A 27-yearold Detroit man was convicted Tuesday of first-degree murder in the 1969 slaying of a Detroit police officer during a bar holdup.

Robert Heard Jr. was sentenced to a mandatory life term in prison and solitary confinement at hard labor for the death of Stanley Rapaski.

It was Heard's second trial and conviction. The Michigan Supreme Court ordered a new trial last year because of errors it said were made by Recorder's Court Judge Joseph A. Gillis.

Rapaski was killed along with bar owner Casimir A. Czerwinski. Heard was not charged with the second slaying. Another suspect shot himself to death, apparently by accident, when cornered by police a few days later. wmen contain toreign-made parts



## Murderer **Gets Solitary** Confinement

DETROIT (AP) - A 27-yearold Detroit man was convicted Tuesday of first-degree murder in the 1969 slaving of a Detroit police officer during a bar holdup.

Robert Heard Jr. was sentenced to a mandatory life term in prison and solitary confinement at hard labor for the death of Stanley Rapaski.

It was Heard's second trial and conviction. The Michigan Supreme Court ordered a new trial last year because of errors it said were made by Recorder's Court Judge Joseph A. Gil-

Rapaski was killed along with bar owner Casimir A. Czerwinski. Heard was not charged with the second slaving. Another suspect shot himself to death, apparently by accident, when cornered by police a few days later.

# Parolee Guilty Of Murdering Policeman

Robert Heard Jr., a 23-year-old burglar on parole, was convicted Thursday of the first-degree murder of a

Detroit policeman during a bar holdup in January. Heard waived a presentence probation report. Recorders Court Judge Joseph A. Gillis immediately sentenced him to a mandatory term of life in prison in solitary confinement at hard labor.

Heard said he would appeal. The jury of 10 women and two men deliberated about an hour after a nine-day trial.

Heard was charged with shooting to death Patrolman Stanley Rapaski, 35, in the Cherry Hill Bar, 4820 E. Davi-son, Jan. 16.

Another suspect in the rob-bery-shooting, Paul Kincan-non, 22, of 3761 Wager, shot himself to death, apparently by accident, when cornered by police in an alley a few days after the murder.

Heard, who last lived rieard, who last lived at 3347 Boston, surrendered to a boyhood friend, Patrolman Dennis Clark, shortly after Kincannon was killed.

The bar owner, Casimir A. Czerwinski, also was shot to death in the holdup. Heard was not charged with that slaying.

THE SLAIN patrolman's widow, Florence Rapaski, 34, who has five young children, testified that she and her husband were sitting in the nearly empty bar when two men walked in. The men sat down and ordered beer. Minutes later one of the men got up, brandished a gun and announced a holdup. nounced a holdup.

Mrs. Rapaski said her hus-band reached for his service revolver but she stood in front of him because she feared if he drew the weapon, he would be killed.

The gunman walked over, put his pistol to Rapaski's head and said: "Don't start anything." Then, Mrs. Rapaski said, he searched the policeman but apparently found only Rapski's wallet.

Then the gunman told every-one in the bar to lie down, the widow said.

THEN, MRS. Rapaski testi-

fied:

"We were lying on the floor.
He (the gunman) pressed the
gun near my husband's head.
He said: "Where is all that
money?" My husband gave
him a check.

"He said: "Where is the
cash money?" My husband
didn't reply. Then, seconds later, I heard a shot. I looked up.

"My husband was on his

"My husband was on his knees. The man was at my feet. I put my head back down.

I heard three more shots. I heard running toward the rear of the store."

Mrs. Rapaski, who had identified Heard in a lineup as the gumman, also identified him in court.

# Policeman Slain In Bar Holdup

DETROIT (AP)—An off-duty Detroit policeman, who disregarded his wife's plea that he not reach for his service revolver to break up a bar holdup, was shot to death early today. The bar owner also was killed.

Patrolman Stanley Rapaski, 35, and the bar owner, Casimir A. Czarwinski, were struck by at least 11 builets, police said. A bar customer, Frank Piotrowski was beaten about the head by the bandits and was hospitalized.

Homicide detectives said the patrolman's wife and mother of his five children was having a quet drink with her husband when two bandits, who had posed as customers for a few minutes, drew out pistols and announced a holdup.

The policeman, who was seated at a table, made a move towards his revolver and one of the bandits saw him and asked what he was doing.





The Judicial Complaint of Misconduct was filed 08-11-2015 regarding Hon. Judge William S. Duffey of No. District of Georgia - Atlanta Div. and Hon. Black, Pryor and Kravitch of 11th Cir. of Appeals with regards to No. District of GA, Case No.: 1:03-CV-00925-JTC / 1:03-CV-00925-WSD Docket no. of any appeal to the 11th Circuit: 04-16688-EE. Complainant Files Petition FOR Dusicial Review in 11-20-2015 In the Bound Judicial Complaint of Misconduct included 70+ pages of supporting documents, Complainant alleged that Hon. Judge William S. Duffey of Northern District of Georgia -Atlanta Division committed the following acts: (1) \*... Treated Litigant in a demonstrably egregious and hostile manner; AND (2) The Court(s) delay of this Complaint arose out of an illicit motive and in order to assist the Def. who are a governmental entity, evade accountability; AND (3) The judge's used their office to offer special treatment when minority Pltf. files suit against governmental agencies; AND (4) Discrimination against minority female litigant on account of race, ethnicity, sex...through manipulation of filings/docket entries: thus, obstructing justice.' - Which, in accordance with Rule 3(h)(3)(A), is not merits-related.1

The Chief Judge, Hon. Ed Carnes, ruled on 10-16-2015 in favor of accused Judges listed in Complaint stating, "allegations of this Complaint 'is directly related to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling," AND 'Apart from the decisions or procedural rulings with which

Rule 3(h)(3)(A) ·...An allegation that a judge ruled against the complainant because [they] a member of a particular racial or ethnic group, or because the judge dislikes the complainant personally, is also not merits-related. Such an allegation attacks the propriety of arriving at rulings with an illicit or improper motive. An allegation that a judge treated litigants, attorneys, or others in a demonstrably egregious and hostile manner while on the bench is also not merits-related.
