My Approach to Communications

Most important things in life are simply the application of effective communication principles. I stress these key communication principles to learners:

- clarifying with the intended recipients that what is to be communicated will be helpful ...before doing so;
- focusing on the needs of the recipients identified by careful and thorough prior research;
- budgeting sufficient time to allow stressless preparation of the communication for all involved, whenever possible;
- making the communication appropriately emotional and personal;
- crafting templates and standard approaches for commonly recurring situations, in advance;
- using a simple but elegant "Communications Guide" to prepare an important communication that focuses it on the benefits of the suggested action for recipients
- asking the recipients to actually take the suggested action in the communication;
- reviewing communications, carefully and personally, before final proof reading by others;
- arranging for advanced peer review, when possible;
- practicing *all* oral presentations with an audience for constructive feedback, prior to delivery, and for me most importantly ...
- having fun while communicating and learning ...always!
