




### Small School Attributes



- We can decide that a change is needed. But what are the Realities of Change?
- Changes mean different things to different people.



- Key points to facilitate substantive, sustained change:
  - Do not be married to anything
  - Build trust
  - Develop strategies to build resilience and fight resistance



- Vision and Leadership:
  - Ensure the academic achievement of all students at high levels
  - Establish supportive rapport and positive relationships
  - Empower students and staff to focus on instruction and youth development
  - Engage families and communities in supporting and sustaining dynamic learning



- A few realities about people:
  - Most people act first in their own self-interest, not in the interest of the school
  - Most people expect to be viewed as having good intentions, even though they view with suspicion the intentions of those initiating organizational change

Research states that when staff are given regular, sustained, on-site support increased student achievement occurs.




Schools will see improvement when facilitators, coaches, experts, provide regular and sustained, on-site support to the staff.
