I DO WANT TO THANK ALL OF THE SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY ALUMNI, DR. TANAKA, DR. TABATA, DEAN REED, THE UMKC ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, AND EVERYONE ELSE WHO HELPED SHAPE THIS EVENT. I AM HONORED TO BE HERE.

I ESPECIALLY WISH TO COMMEND SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY ALUMNI FOR THEIR PASSIONATE SUPPORT OF THE SCHOOL.

THE HAWAIIAN DENTAL ALUMNI, AS EVIDENCED BY THE TURNOUT FOR TODAY'S MEETING AND BY YOUR ANNUAL PILGRIMAGE TO KANSAS CITY FOR THE MIDWEST DENTAL CONFERENCE AND ALUMNI MEETING, IS AMONG THE MOST PASSIONATE.

THIS RELATIONSHIP STANDS AS AN EXCELLENT ROLE MODEL FOR ALL UMKC STUDENTS WHEN THEY GRADUATE INTO THE REAL WORLD.

ANOTHER TYPE OF ROLE MODELING IS SERVICE
BACK TO THE COMMUNITY THAT UMKC HAS
PLEDGED TO SERVE. ONE EXAMPLE WOULD BE DR.
MICHAEL MCCUNIFF AND DR. HARVEY EPLEE, WHO
ARE HELPING TO IMPROVE ORAL HEALTH
PROGRAMS IN RURAL MISSOURI.

IT IS MY HOPE THAT YOUR PASSION FOR THE SCHOOL'S FUTURE ALSO EXTENDS TO THE UNIVERSITY'S FUTURE.

ACTUALLY, I KNOW THIS IS ALREADY TRUE. THERE ARE A LOT OF EXCITING THINGS HAPPENING AT UMKC. I'M PLEASED TO TELL YOU ABOUT SOME OF THEM NOW.

AN IMPORTANT BIT OF NEWS IS THAT MISSOURI GOVERNOR CARNAHAN HAS RECOMMENDED MORE THAN \$94 MILLION IN ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR HIGHER EDUCATION IN MISSOURI. THE 7.2 PERCENT INCREASE IS THE LARGEST SINCE 1986.

AT UMKC, THE LONG-AWAITED SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY BUILDING IS WELL INTO THE DEVELOPMENT STAGE. WHEN BUILT, IT WILL BE A MAJOR BOON TO EDUCATIONAL AND RESEARCH EFFORTS AT UMKC.

A BIT OF SAD NEWS. LAST FALL, ROBERT FLARSHEIM, A LONG-TIME FRIEND OF UMKC AND MY NEXT DOOR NEIGHBOR FOR MANY YEARS — PASSED AWAY. HE THOUGHTFULLY HONORED UMKC WITH A GIFT OF MORE THAN \$8.7 MILLION, TO BE USED FOR ENHANCING UMKC.

NOT ALL BENEFACTORS OF UMKC MAKE THIS KIND OF ONE-TIME IMPACT, BUT EVERY GIFT DOES MAKE A DIFFERENCE. LAST YEAR 13,500 PEOPLE GAVE MORE THAN 21,000 GIFTS OF VARIOUS AMOUNTS TO UMKC.

OUR ENDOWED CHAIRS AND PROFESSORSHIPS PROGRAM CONTINUES TO THRIVE.

AS WE NEAR THE HALFWAY MARK TO OUR GOAL OF 30 BY THE YEAR 2000, I CAN TELL YOU THAT A GLIMPSE INTO THE HORIZON REVEALS AS MANY AS FIVE NEW CHAIRS AND PROFESSORSHIPS OVER THE NEXT YEAR OR SO. MANY OF THESE, LIKE MANY OF OUR PREVIOUS ONES, WILL QUALIFY FOR THE MISSOURI MATCH PROGRAM.

A RECENT ACCOUNTING BY OUR ADVANCEMENT DIVISION NOTES THAT THE CURRENT VALUE OF ALL ENDOWMENTS AT UMKC IS ABOUT \$80 MILLION. THIS IS ESSENTIAL IN ENSURING UMKC CAN COMPETE FAVORABLY FOR THE NATION'S TOP SCHOLAR-TEACHERS.

BY APRIL, UMKC WILL HAVE COMPLETED A
COMPREHENSIVE STRATEGIC PLAN OF A SCOPE
THAT INCLUDED UMKC'S ADMINISTRATIVE
LEADERSHIP, FACULTY, STAFF, STUDENTS, ALUMNI
AND THE UNIVERSITY OF KANSAS CITY
TRUSTEES...17 PLANNING TEAMS IN ALL.

THE RESULT WILL BE SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES AND ACTION ITEMS THAT WILL ADVANCE UMKC'S LONG-RANGE VISION. OUR MISSION STATEMENT IS TO BECOME "A PREMIER URBAN UNIVERSITY."

IN APRIL, I WILL PRESENT A TOP-TO-BOTTOM STRATEGIC PLAN FOR UMKC TO THE BOARD OF CURATORS.

A GLIMPSE INTO THIS VISION SHOWS THAT THE SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY IS A MAJOR PLAYER IN HELPING US FULFILL THE PROMISE OF OUR MISSION STATEMENT.

LET ME GIVE YOU SOME EXAMPLES. UMKC'S INTERDISCIPLINARY PH.D. PROGRAM WILL RECEIVE FUNDING THAT WILL MOVE UMKC TO CARNEGIE FOUNDATION RESEARCH II STATUS...MARKING UMKC AS ONE OF THE ELITE RESEARCH INSTITUTIONS IN AMERICA.

THE PLAN INCLUDES A STRATEGY FOR ENHANCING THE SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY'S ORAL BIOLOGY FACULTY AND EXTERNAL RESEARCH FUNDING FOR THE MASTER'S AND INTERDISCIPLINARY PH.D. THE GOAL IS TO PLACE THE DENTAL SCHOOL AMONG THE TOP FIVE OF THE NATION'S 54 DENTAL SCHOOLS BY THE YEAR 2002.

ANOTHER INITIATIVE OF THE PLAN IS TO DEVELOP EMPHASES THAT PLACE UMKC IN A LEADERSHIP ROLE IN EMERGING FIELDS.

THESE IMPROVEMENTS AND ENHANCEMENTS WILL TOUCH COMPUTER SCIENCE, LAW, THE COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES, BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES AND THE CONSERVATORY.

AND WHAT IS YOUR PART IN THIS PLAN? STAY INVOLVED. KEEP IN TOUCH. ASK QUESTIONS. TOGETHER, WE CAN MAKE UMKC THE KIND OF UNIVERSITY YOU AND I KNOW IT CAN BE — AND MUST BE IN THE NEW ERA AHEAD OF US.

AT THE BEGINNING I ASSURED YOU THAT I DIDN'T BRING ANY OF KANSAS CITY'S SUB-FREEZING WEATHER WITH ME BUT WOULD YOU MIND TERRIBLY IF I TOOK <u>A LITTLE</u> OF YOUR WEATHER BACK WITH ME?
