- Our whole-person emphasis includes an on-campus fitness facility, community room, a childcare center, multiple computer stations, well-equipped library, and a private room for moms.

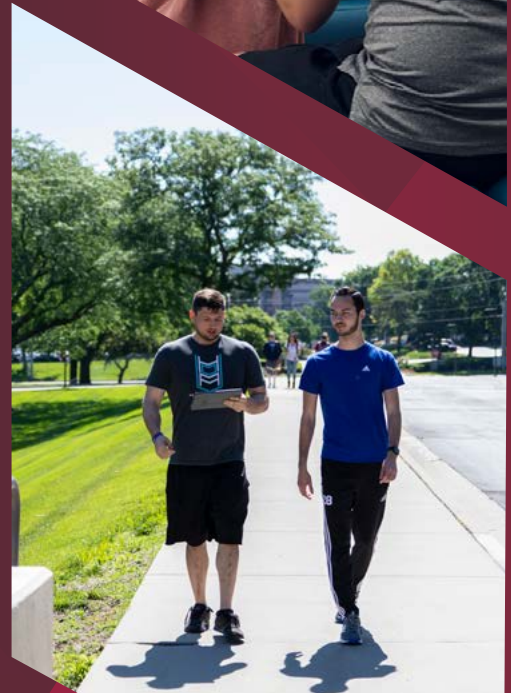
CUKC: ACADEMIC AND STUDENT SUPPORT

FINANCIAL AID. WE'RE HERE TO ASSIST YOU.

We'll guide you step-by-step, before you enroll, while you're in school, and before graduation. Here's how:

ON-CAMPUS WORK-STUDY

CUKC's active Federal Work-Study program means that eligible students can earn money to help pay for educational expenses without taking on additional loans.

\$200,000+ IN SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships include the CUKC A+ scholarships, memorial scholarships, plus those from external organizations. Scholarships also extend to associate and bachelor's degree programs.

AID FOR U.S. MILITARY MEMBERS AND VETERANS

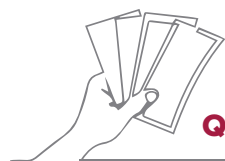
CUKC participates in many programs for active duty military members and veterans, such as the Veterans Administration Post-911 and Yellow Ribbon programs.

LOANS & GRANTS

Our staff meets with you to discuss any qualifying grant opportunities and loan amounts before you make these commitments. There are many financial options to support your career choice. We also discuss plans for paying back loans after graduation.

FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID

CUKC participates in the U.S. Dept. of Education federal financial aid programs. Include the CUKC school code **014438** in your FAFSA form at fafsa.edu.gov.



Q. WHAT ARE THE TUITION AND FEES FOR CUKC?

A. Each program has different costs and you can find details online in the [tuition and cost section of cleveland.edu](https://tuitionandcostsectionofcleveland.edu) under admissions. The costs for the doctor of chiropractic program are a flat per-trimester tuition. This means the tuition includes lab, technology, and various student activity fees. To ensure a solid understanding of degree costs, contact an admissions advisor who can discuss educational costs and financial aid resources with you.

KANSAS CITY. A BIG-TIME CITY THAT FEELS LIKE HOME.

Coming to CUKC means living in an area with an inviting mix of opportunities, possibilities, and “feels right” livability. Our cost of living is lower than most U.S. metro areas – 20% lower than Chicago, 16.3% lower than Dallas and 10.8% less than St. Louis, for example.

With a population of more than 1.5 million, the Kansas City Metro straddles the Kansas/Missouri state line. If you’re not too familiar with the KC Metro, you may be surprised to find a gently rolling, heavily treed environment with well-kept streets, interstate highways, and boulevards.

You’ll also find plenty of pedestrian and bike trails, planned park areas, and opportunities to participate in sports of every kind, from disc golf to axe throwing, plus golf, tennis, softball and soccer.

Entertainment options include the Kauffman Center for the Performing Arts and many other theatre venues, museums, arts and culture districts, and numerous shopping possibilities. Food and culture festivals are also plentiful, and if these are not enough, check out the NASCAR action at the Kansas Speedway just across the state line.

Collegiate sports are big in KC. If you love basketball, you’ll love Big 12 basketball tournaments at the T-Mobile Center. We’re also home to professional sports teams:

- MLB’s Royals, 2-time MLB World Champion
- Sporting Kansas City professional men’s soccer
- Kansas City Current, professional women’s soccer
- Kansas City Comets professional indoor soccer
- Kansas City Mavericks minor league hockey
- Kansas City Monarchs, minor league baseball.



Q. WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT KANSAS CITY?

A. Foodies love Kansas City, which is renowned for its tasty barbecue. However, dining in KC brings you many ethnic restaurants plus more traditional dining options. You’ll also enjoy the many craft beer breweries, and the unique experiences of the shops and eateries in the Crossroads, Power & Light, downtown, and Riverfront districts. It’s easy to get around in the Kansas City region, thanks to broad avenues and boulevards and an expansive Interstate highway system. Our new \$1.5 billion Kansas City International Airport opened in spring 2023.



OVERLAND PARK. THE RIGHT PLACE FOR YOUR FUTURE.

Sometimes, people are puzzled about the KC Metro situated on the Kansas and Missouri state line.

All you need to know is that the CUKC campus is in the heart of Overland Park, Kan., only a 15-minute drive from downtown Kansas City, Mo.

The city of Overland Park features a well-balanced combination of apartments and homes, museums, parks, and stores for daily needs. It's a large city that feels much smaller.

That's why Overland Park is recognized nationally as one of the "Top 25 Best Places to Live in the Midwest," one of the "Best Mid-Size Cities in the United States," and one of the "Best Cities for Jobs" just to name a few.

Time on campus is more important than time in your car, and students from all over the Kansas City area find Overland Park's pace a welcome break from city traffic.

And because CUKC is a private, nonprofit university, the costs of attending are the same regardless of where our students come from.



Q. IS OVERLAND PARK A SUBURB OR A CITY?

A. It's both. "OP" is a city that feels like a suburb because of its devotion to expansive green space and street design. Spacious parks and many recreational facilities add to Overland Park's appeal. One of our alumni, Dr. A.J. Hernandez, said he came to KC thinking it would be flat ground and a bunch of farmland. "I found the campus and the city amazingly vibrant – walking paths, biking trails, and easy access to nearby lakes. Whatever an active lifestyle looks like to you, it's here."

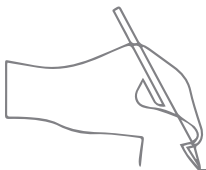
